1 SUBJECT: Yes on I-1163

 5 WHEREAS: The WSCFF provides endorsements and recommendations for candidates and
 6 initiatives; and
 7

8 WHEREAS: Service Employees International Union (SEIU) represents long-term care workers
 9 throughout the state, and has advocated for legislation that calls for certification,
 10 training standards, and background checks for those workers since 2007; and
 11

12 WHEREAS: These legislative efforts have not been successful, therefore SEIU authored and
 13 passed WSCFF endorsed Initiative 1029 in November 2008; and
 14

15 WHEREAS: This year the Washington State Legislature reduced the training requirements and
 16 delayed criminal background checks called for in I-1029, putting Washington State
 17 residents at risk; now therefore be it

 20 RESOLVED: That the WSCFF 72nd Convention go on record in support of Initiative 1163 and
 21 transmit our endorsement to SEIU and the Yes on I-1163 campaign.
