California EMAC Deployment 2025

- **11 Strike teams deployed with 2 A-Reps**
- **55 total Apparatus deployed**
- **Where did they go**
- **What did they do**
- **What did we learn**
- **Does your agency still have an EMAC agreement on file?**



Impacts to Wildland Response from FED Cuts

- **Morale of the Federal workforce is very low**
- **Generally, it appears Washington State Forest Service Offices have not seen any impacts**
- **Nationally there have been cutbacks for training.**



State Budget Cuts – What we know

- **HB1168 funding Cut Impacts**
- **DNR Engine Crew reductions from 4 person to 3 person**
- **Reduction in Aviation by cutting 2 SEAT Aircraft from Yakima**



CBA Language in conflict with State Mobe

- There have been instances where agencies are attempting to bill State Mobe based on CBA language specific to State Mobe.
EXAMPLE: A CBA may say that “when on dispatched to a Fire IA and the incident becomes a MOBE all personnel assigned to the incident shall automatically be paid a minimum of 14 hours”
- The Fire Marshals Office will only pay what is allowed in the rules set forth from the state, a CBA does not supersede those rules.



IAFF Response to the Interface Course

- Held in Spokane June 2024 hosted by Local 29
- Developed by the IAFF Wildfire Taskforce
- Regional Concept with 6 different agencies represented in three states
- IAFF Instructors from Around the US and Canada
- Train the Trainer driven so you can take it back home and deliver it
- Three days of classroom and one field day

- Additional funding passed at Convention in Boston
- Working to obtain a seat on the NWCG
- Working with Congress to build a stand alone all Risk Agency
- Working with Boise State on new Wildland Respiratory protection System






Installing the Web App Icon on your Mobile device




Click the three dots in the top right and click install app:









Turn your phone to landscape to view the photo larger. Pinch the photo to enlarge again.










If you have an android phone the button on the left will take you straight to your messaging app
