Brothers and Sisters:

The WSCFF relies on member participation to fulfill our mission of providing the best possible working conditions, the safest work environment, and the fairest wages and benefits to fulfill the needs of the men and women in this profession.

The delegates assembled at the WSCFF 85th Annual Convention in Vancouver, Washington, adopted Resolution 24-09, which directs us to increase the size of the Standing Emergency Medical Services Committee from three (3) at-large members to six (6). The resolution specifically requires the EMS Committee to have equal representation from both the east and west sides of our great state.

The following is a brief description of the tasks associated with this committee, and the number of meetings per year:

*... the WSCFF EMS Committee will focus on legislation, education, and employment opportunities for our members in cooperation with the legislative team...and [will] modify its meeting schedule to meet up to four (4) times annually, with two (2) of those meetings held virtually.*

The EMS Committee Co-Chair will provide the authorization approval to utilize WSCFF work replacement and compensation days for the meetings.

**The process to select the committee members will be as follows:**

- Interested WSCFF members must submit a letter explaining why they should be considered to serve on the committee.
- Each applying member must also submit a letter of support from their local president or secretary-treasurer identifying that the member is in good standing.
